Despite it all, we at our little MAC, are still moving forward with the work we are called to do:

(1) We are meeting our financial obligations and have built back our Building Fund. Not only that, but we have enough money in our Future's Fund to allow us to print up our own tracts and little booklets. Right now, we have one of each, not yet in final form, and more will be coming.

(5) The new book, right now entitled *Psychic Therapies* (no subtitle yet), is nearly complete, and my goal is to have it ready for editing by mid-August. (Katie will be doing the editing.)

On a personal family note, let me describe how things are with Katie and me. First, Katie has finished five out of eight chemo treatments, which are no fun, and we have to schedule things around her good days and bad days. Due to the unusual kind of cancer, the chemo is necessary, and the stuff they put into her is supposed to seek out any cancer cells and kill them. Katie is tough and she is fighting.

Then me, well I have to confess that I made, well maybe made, a mistake. I am coaching football at Terra Linda High, only able to be there

Tuesdays and Wednesdays, because we are in the studio every Thursday afternoon. The regular season starts the middle of August, so I have to get the book done by then. We have 8 coaches, 4 for varsity and 4 for soph-frosh, and I am with the latter. And this may be the best possible witness, because the players will spot me on TV. I get recognized regularly when I am out and about, and it shows that our work is not in vain.

Last, let me say that Katie and I are convinced that the new book dealing with everything from Reiki, Akashic Records, mediumship and channeling, Kundalini, the Third Eye, life coaching, crystal healing, Tarot, Ouija Board, yoga, and “mindfulness” meditation, and much more, is incredibly important.
