Into our third year with the pandemic, and it is exhausting some of us, which is no surprise. Sometimes I think we do not take the impact of what we are going through as seriously as we should. I will admit that life is tough for me right now. And Katie--done with the chem-- and she has been struggling lately, and then a CT scan soon to see if there are any more tumors.
