

**Jesus Foretells His Death a Third Time &
Jesus Heals a Blind Beggar
Luke 18:31–43**

1. On His way to Jerusalem with His disciples, along with throngs of others going up to the city for Passover, Jesus, for the third time says that He will be given over to the Gentiles who will mistreat Him and also kill Him. Not only that, but that He will also rise from the dead. But again, they do not understand Him.
2. Crossing over the Jordan River, they come to the city of Jericho. (There were two sites for the city, the old one built by the Jews and also a newer city built by Romans.)
3. Now a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging, which was common, and there were likely many more hoping for offerings from the pilgrims headed toward Jerusalem. (Matthew speaks of two beggars.)
4. The beggar, upon hearing that Jesus was passing by, cries out, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me.” Son of David was a messianic term used by Jews in that era. Jesus stops and has the blind man brought to Him.
5. The man pleads for Jesus to heal him, and Jesus does so, saying to him, “Your faith has made you well.” And that faith would be that not only could Jesus heal him but that He is the promised Messiah.
6. The man now becomes a follower of Jesus, and those who witness it give glory to God.

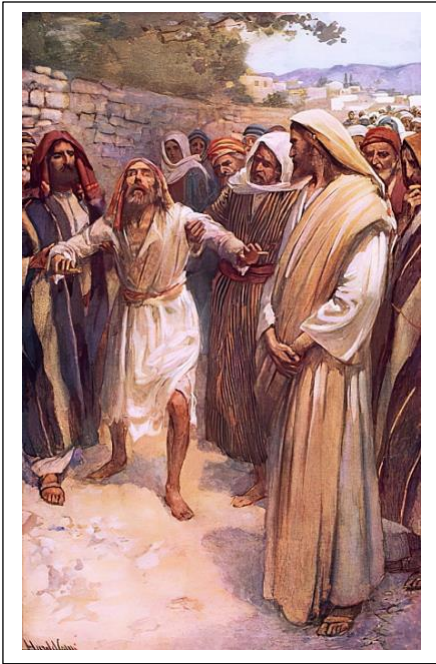
