

Bear One Another's Burdens
Galatians 6:1–10

1. Paul does understand that, though one believes in Jesus and has salvation, this person is not without sinful behavior, and it is the duty of others to restore such a person when the need arises.
2. And with this admonition, one must remember that all of us can be tempted and deceived.
3. We are called to “test” our actions and prevent them from setting the stage for boasting.
4. Paul calls upon those who are being taught to provide for their teachers, and this is vital for us—as we behave toward others, so we will be treated.
5. Sowing to the flesh, Paul then explains, leads only to corruption, but the opposite is true for those who “sow” to the Spirit, and this is a “reaping” of eternal life.
6. And it is often difficult to bear one another's burdens, yet the results will come along "in due season."
7. So then, as opportunity presents itself, we want to do good to those who need it, and this includes all people but especially to those who belong to Christ.

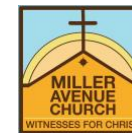
