The Gospel Meditation

Jesus Calms a Storm, Jesus Heals a Demon-Possessed Man Mark 4:35–5:20

- Jesus decides to cross the Sea of Galilee by boat, and this after a grueling day previously. They set out, accompanied by other boats carrying His followers.
- 2. Jesus, being exhausted, falls asleep in the stern of the boat, while a fierce wind stirs up the waves into a frightful event. He is awakened by His disciples who express to Him their fear.
- 3. Awake now, Jesus rebukes the wind and calms the sea, whereupon He asks His disciples why they were so afraid. They are flabbergasted that even the wind and sea obey Him.
- 4. As soon as Jesus sets foot on the northeasterly shore of the Galilee Sea, inhabited mostly by Gentiles, a man with an unclean spirit, meaning a demon, rushes up to Him.
- 5. This man has enormous strength, and no one has been able to deal with him. He has been a disaster, even inflicting pain upon himself.
- 6. Jesus addresses not the man, but the leading demonic spirit in him, who pleads with Jesus not to torment him, and this because Jesus was saying to the demon that it must come out of the man.
- 7. A large herd of pigs are nearby, and the demons beg Jesus to send them into them, likely to keep from being sent into hell instead. Jesus consents to this, resulting in the pigs rushing into the sea and drowning.
- 8. Now the formerly possessed man, clothed and in his right mind, is with Jesus. He hopes that he can remain with Him, whereupon Jesus says that he should go home and tell them what has happened to him. He does so, proclaiming how much Jesus has done for him.
