Jesus Heals a Woman & Jairus' Daughter Mark 5:21–43

- 1. Upon His return from the Decapolis, Jesus arrives by boat somewhere near Capernaum and is greeted by a large crowd, among whom is a man named Jairus, a leader in the local synagogue, who implores Jesus to heal his little daughter who is near death.
- 2. Among those following Jesus is a woman who has suffered much with a bleeding issue for the last twelve years. She hopes to get close enough to Jesus to be able to touch even just the fringe of the garment He is wearing.
- 3. She is able to do so, whereupon Jesus immediately knows He has been touched, and this He mentions out loud. His disciples reply in amazement that He could know, with so many people crowding in.
- 4. Though Jesus does not spot the woman, she comes up to Him in "fear and trembling." Jesus then says to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well, go in peace, and be healed of your disease."
- 5. While this is taking place, someone from the home of Jairus announces to Jesus that the little girl is dead, whereupon Jesus responds, "Do not fear; only believe."
- 6. With only the inner three—Peter, James, and John—Jesus enters into Jairus' home, and seeing numbers of people, probably professional mourners common in that era and culture, Jesus says she is not dead but is only sleeping. This response has remained a mystery ever since.
- 7. Though some laugh at Him, He puts these folks out and enters the room where the dead girl is and says in Aramaic, "Talitha cumi" meaning "Little girl, I say to you, arise."
- 8. And the twelve-year-old does arise and begins to walk. Jesus then says to those around Him that they are not to spread the word of this around to others, then says that they should give the now-healed girl something to eat.
