Jesus Foretells His Death a Third Time Mark 10:32–34

- 1. On their way to Jerusalem for the last time, Jesus walks ahead of those who are following—the twelve disciples and likely a larger group. It is not clear why Jesus walks on ahead.
- 2. As they travel, Jesus begins for the third time to describe what is about to happen to Him. This is likely very difficult for them to hear since they have many times seen His miraculous power to heal, even raise the dead, and cast out demons.
- 3. He refers to Himself as the "Son of Man," a term found in the book of Daniel and therefore familiar to the Jews. The term "Son of God," which Jesus uses to describe who He is, is also found in the Gospel writer's account. It is a way of referring to Himself as being the promised Messiah.
- 4. Despite all the miracles that Jesus has done, the religious leaders, the Sadducees and Pharisees, will still condemn Him to death. Plus, they will engage with the Gentiles—Pontius Pilate and company.
- 5. And the treatment He will receive, that which only the worst of the worst would experience, will include mocking, spiting on Him, flogging Him, then killing Him.
- 6. Thus, Jesus warns and prepares His followers for what is coming, but this is only the ending of the beginning, for He will rise from the dead.




