

Signs of the End of the Age Mark 13:3–13

1. Now just two days away from the crucifixion, Jesus, with Peter, James, John, and Andrew, are sitting on the western slope of the Mount of Olives and are looking across the Kidron Valley with the Temple less than two miles away to the west.
2. They ask Jesus to tell them when all that He has told them will come to pass.
3. Jesus begins with a warning that no one lead them astray, since there will be other end time views presented. In fact, Jesus says that many false prophets will lead many astray.
4. Jesus then lists events to come, including wars and threats of war, indeed, nations will war with other nations, yet these are merely the beginning of terrible things to come.
5. Jesus informs the four disciples that those who follow Him will be subjected to tragic events, yet this must not dissuade His followers as they continue to present the Good News to all nations.
6. He even says that they need not be anxious when these events take place, for the Holy Spirit will speak through them.
7. Jesus goes on to say that even family members will betray them up to death, even a father his child and a child against parents—a most frightful time.
8. His last warning is that His followers will be hated because of their believing in Him. Yet, they will endure to the end.

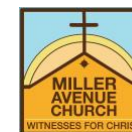
