Gospel Meditation The Abomination of Desolation & The Coming of the Son of Man Mark 13:14–27

- 1. The "abomination of desolation" is thought to be what Daniel wrote of in Daniel 7:23–28 and which refers to the events of 70 AD and the Roman destruction of the Temple and Jerusalem.
- 2. Yet, it also applies, in principle, to the time prior to the 2nd Coming of Jesus, at the end of the age of our universe.
- 3. Jesus warns His disciples and all Christians down through the ages what they can expect, which is a whole history of deception and confusion and all-out war on those who trust in Jesus as the Messiah, the Christ of God. Thus it has been throughout the ages, but then there is the ultimate climax at the end of the age.
- 4. Just prior then to the end of the ages, dramatic events begin to unfold. The entire universe undergoes it's ending, then suddenly the Son of Man, Jesus Himself, "comes in the clouds" or from that which is above with great power and glory.
- 5. At this point, all the followers of Jesus yet on the planet are gathered and saved from the destruction of the entire universe.
- 6. This is the great pronouncement of Jesus just a day or so before His crucifixion, burial, resurrection, and accession.
