Gospel Meditation
The Passover with the Disciples & Institution of the Lord's Supper
Mark 14:12–25

1. The first “Passover” took place as part of God’s instructions to Moses for freeing the Israelite slaves from Egypt. They sacrificed a lamb and put it’s blood on the lintel and sides of the doors of their homes. Seeing the blood, the death angel ‘passed over’ that house.
2. This took place some 1,500 years before the time of Jesus, and down through the centuries this “Passover” feast was practiced by the Jews.
3. Jesus celebrated it with His disciples, just a day before He would be crucified. It is known as the “Last Supper,” and as they ate, Jesus, lifted up unleavened bread and said it was His body. He then said the wine in the cup was His blood of the covenant. Then He told them He would not drink again of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God had come, when He would do so again with them.
4. This has been held by Jesus’ followers down through the centuries as Jesus’ promise of eternal life to come with Him and with the whole of those who found salvation in Him.
5. The elements themselves, the bread and the wine, are not magically empowered or changed. It is a reminder and a statement of the saving power of the death and resurrection of Jesus.
6. There is no direction in Scripture as to how often these elements are to be received. Some do so weekly, others monthly, some once a year. Nor is there anything magical about it. Rather, it is an act of faith and obedience.

Notes:

Apostles' Creed

I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary.

He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.

He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of the saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen
