Gospel Meditation "Wives and Husbands" Ephesians 5:22–33

- 1. Marriage in the days before Jesus was quite different, wives being little more than slaves, while Jewish people with their Hebrew Bible were taught differently.
- 2. Paul is writing to Gentiles (non-Jews) and found it necessary to communicate with them about what biblical marriage was, especially in regard to the status of women.
- 3. In verses 22 to 24, Paul speaks to married women, while the rest of the verses have men as the primary focus.
- 4. Wives are to "submit" to their husbands, while husbands are to love (*agape*) their wives, much more than to only "submit." And this a radical departure from the culture at the time.
- 5. Paul then illustrates the above with the relationship between Christ and the Church. Christ is the head of the church—the body—who gave Himself up for it at His crucifixion and death.
- 6. Husbands are to love (*agape*) their wives, and in doing so actually love themselves, since the married couple are one flesh.
- 7. In verse 32, Paul acknowledges that this is a mystery, even a profound mystery, and states that the married state is like that of Christ and the church.
- 8. Husbands are called to the highest duty, to love their wives as themselves, and the wife is to respect, therefore receive this love.

Notes:

Apostles' Creed

I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ. His only Son. our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of the saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen
