# Gospel Meditation Children and Parents / Bondservants and Masters Ephesians 6:1–9

- 1. In verses one to four Paul addresses children, and by children is meant sons and daughters who are yet living at home. He states they are to "obey" and "honor" their parents.
- 2. As to the full meaning of "obey," commentators differ. It may be noted that the phrase, "in the Lord" in verse one is iffy, and my view is that it was added on later in order to make clear Paul's meaning.
- 3. Also, the word "honor" in verse two is not easily defined, and Paul says this is the "first commandment." By so doing, children will "live long in the land," likely referring to the believer's eternal life.
- 4. Then Paul warns "fathers" not to be angry with their children but to treat them as the Lord would.
- 5. Secondly, Paul states that "bondservants" (in the ESV,) but the word in Greek is *doulos*, meaning slave, are to seriously obey their masters, as much as or like they are to obey Christ.
- 6. In that era, it is noted that about one third of the population were slaves. This was the custom and had been for centuries.
- 7. The faithfulness of slaves to their masters would result in good for them.
- 8. Then, Paul urges "masters" of slaves to treat their *doulos* as he instructed slaves to treat their masters: "Knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord."
- 9. In conclusion, Paul reminds both master and slave that they both have a "Master" in heaven to obey.

Notes:

#### **Apostles' Creed**

I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary.

He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.

He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again. He ascended into heaven

and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again

to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of the saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen
